## 1. AR&D Update (7:00-7:10PM)

- a. Margaret gave an update on Admissions and answered guestions:
  - i. The 2023-2024 academic year started with just under 500 students. This includes 53 legacies, 120 riders, and 110 athletes.
  - ii. New admissions counselors (SBC alumnae!) have been traveling across the country, visiting college fairs, high schools, guidance counselors, etc
  - iii. Emily Sadler has moved to Admissions as Assistant Director and we know she will be an important part of that team as she was in the Alumnae Relations Office
  - iv. Submitted applications and admitted applications are up over 20% from last year at this time. And inquiries are also up.
  - v. Delay in the new FAFSA system has caused lower deposits from this time of year but the College expects this to quickly right itself now that the system is up and running and families will know the financial picture for attending Sweet Briar.
  - vi. The college feels very positive about our final outcome and reaching the goal 225 incoming class goal

#### 2. Working Group Updates

- a. Sweet Work Weeks
  - i. No dates at this time but the window that they are looking at is July 27-August 10
  - ii. Not sure if we will have a spring event this year due to coverage and projects that can be completed

# d. Young Alumnae Support

- Assisting with Sweet Briar Day outreach and asking those they reach out to to contact at least three people to encourage them to attend
- ii. Overall more engagement and turn out this year over last year.Exciting!
- iii. Introducing a group chat to send reminders about things to do within the working group to continue building their community
- iv. Planning a wine event in partnership with CEO
- v. Finalize date for Valentine's date 2/2 with CEO. They are also planning on doing additional Valentines.
