AR&D Updates

- February is Black History Month & I Love Sweet Briar Month; More details about Black history Month— Facebook's Now & Forever Page: "To honor and celebrate Black History Month, the Black Student Alliance (BSA), alongside various departments on campus, has planned a series of events with the theme "Afrofierce: The Fierce Urgency of the Moment." Afrofierce is the "celebration of Black culture through various mediums such as the arts, media, and literature." BSA is presenting a "cohesive set of programming designed to educate, celebrate, and support the existence and excellence of the Black experience in 2021 and the years to come." Each Monday throughout Black History Month, we will share the week's programming. To kick off this week there will be two events. The first is an open conversation discussing the theme Afrofierce titled "Weaving Together." Then on Friday evening, the "Heal n' Paint" event will focus on collective stress relief and healing through artistic expression. With music, fun conversations, and a blank canvas for each person, we will paint a picture centering around their interpretation, perspective, or expression of Afrofierce.
