- Participation Goal for This Year is 30%; current participation rate is 19.7%; we need 1,293 additional new donors to reach 30% -participation is so important for the national rankings, such as U.S.News & World Report, as well as grants & endowment requirements; great time to email your class & reconnect; we had a record number of donors for March Days of Giving (approximately 1600 donors)
