- & fire hydrants, power washed a lot of areas, and the landscaping team did a wonderful job all over campus wedding, mulching etc. The whole time having fun working together to make it all happen.
- Additional Description: landscaping the roundabouts and other flower beds have been weeded and mulched; benches have been scrubbed;; the outdoor furniture in front of the Vixen Den and down in the Lower Quad have a new coat of paint; the gates have been cleaned; and the fire hydrants repainted.
