SBC alumna and artist, Catherine Peek '01, will be on campus to help refresh her sculpture titled "Uplift" located behind the Library.
- -Members of the Class of 1976 returned to campus on October 9-10 for a mini-Reunion to celebrate the life of their classmate, Martha "Ookie" Hays Cooper. Joined by Congressman Jim Cooper and Ookie's children, the class enjoyed tours of campus and our agricultural enterprises. Ookie was an avid birder both personally and professionally; her early days studying ornithology at Sweet Briar with Professor Ernest "Buck Edwards" launched a career at the Bird Division of the Smithsonian Institution to staff the first and second editions of the National Geographic Field Guide to the Birds of North America. However, the weekend celebration of Ookie's life was more than just a gathering. Ookie's friends and classmates also made contributions to Sweet Briar in order to build a birding observation deck in loving memory of this remarkable woman. Sweet Briar's Audubon Campus Conservation Chapter is delighted to be able to use the deck for spotting the many species of birds at Lower Lake.
