AR&D Updates

-Mary Pope Hutson '83 joined the call to provide updates on the amazing things happening at Sweet Briar, including:

-Philanthropy Week. An on-campus event supporting acts of kindness and generosity, held from Monday, November 1 through Sunday, November 7. Organized by Emily Sadler '18 with help from SBC student leaders and campus clubs. Emily shared details on some of the week's activities: The community clean-up at the Sweet Briar Plantation Burial Grounds, organized by the SBC Black Student Alliance; A sewing marathon for students to create items to donate to Miriam's House in Lynchburg, organized by The Crafty Vixen; Students signed thank you cards to the awesome alumnae donors who made gifts to Sweet Briar on #GivingTuesday.

-#GivingTuesday. Many thanks to alumnae and friends for helping us exceed two goals this year. Our first goal celebrated 116 years of Sweet Briar by reaching 116 donors. We surpassed our second goal of an additional 116 donors, for a total of 232 donors — and counting! We turned the live tracking map of the United States pink, with SBC supporters in every state making a their gift to Sweet Briar. Final results are still being tallied and will be announced soon.

-The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), Sweet Briar's accrediting body, has reaffirmed the College's accreditation. Every accredited college and university goes through the two-yearlong reaffirmation process every 10 years. This is an outstanding seal of approval for Sweet Briar. Read more about the process here.
