 - a. Norma Valentine has joined the AR&D office as an Alumnae Relations Associate; one focus will be on coordination with the "Friends Of..." groups. She will also be our Communications liaison for the Council.
 - b. Lee Anne Chaskes and Claire will continue to be the liaisons to the Council as well as for Sweet Work Weeks.
 - c. December events on campus included a dance recital, tree lighting, return of the choir.
 - d. Three Sweet Briar Days have been held thus far: NC, Lynchburg, and Peninsula (aka Tidewater VA) see below for more details.
 - e. Rachel Pietsch continues to work with the college on a part time basis to bridge gaps; a new Administrative Assistant will begin on Jan 2.
- 3. Working Group Key Needs or Questions (7:15-7:25PM)
 - a. Young Alumnae Support (Jackie Vari)
 - i. In November YAS discovered an issue with the online sign up form and it has since been resolved. Membership is now up to 37
 - ii. Charcuterie Board event will be Feb 9; scheduled for all students and will become an annual event

- iii. Working with local clubs to coordinate Sweet Briar Day outreach and add new members.
- b. Governance and Strategic Initiatives (Jess Hiveley)
 - Group has not met recently; started to review the Principles of Governance but recommend additional work to be done to review AAC as a whole (see below #4)
- c. Alumnae Clubs (Kelly Collins *stepping in for Catherine Springer*)
 - 20 Sweet Briar Day events upcoming in January, the list has recently been posted on the Now and Forever Facebook page
- d. Class Leadership (Kelly Collins)
 - Giving Tuesday results included participation from 39 states, with 317 gifts totaling \$227,357
 - i. There were 467 donors in 2023
- e. Alumnae Communications (Sara Story)
 - i. Holiday post scheduled for Dec 20

- f. Admissions Ambassadors (Katrina Bills)
 - i. Group met with Tricia Fallon this week
 - ii. Recent Scholars Weekend was well attended; there will beadmission events every month starting in January
 - iii. As of 12/19, 46 students have sent in deposits (on par with last year)
 - iv. 59 college fairs were attended by AAs this fall
 - v. New Admissions Director has moved to campus and started in his role
 - vi. Targeted marketing (digital media, email) will feature a campaign called "Step Up and Stand Out" inviting prospective students to apply for one of only 225 spots
 - vii. Additional note from Epiphany via email: proposed collaboration between AAs and Comms to create an AA "volunteerism" promotion
